

THE APPROACH FOR ASSESSMENT.

It is not the intention of FEDANSA to fail any candidate in their effort to attain their coaching license, but the intention to assist in achieving such goal. Therefore:-

- At no stage will the examiner/assessor pose any question to the candidate to trick him/her to answer wrongly.
- The candidate will be informed before hand on how the assessment will be managed giving them and their trainer ample time to prepare for the assessment.
- The final result shall determine whether the candidate is competent or incompetent.
- At assessment the candidate will be informed of areas that needs improvements and will only be assessed on those areas at re-assessment. Time allowed for re-assessment is 60 days and attempts for re-assessments, three attempts.
- The National Technical Advisory will inform interested persons of Service Providers that will assist them.
- FEDANSA National Executive will be solely responsible for the appointment of examiners/assessors.
- The National Technical Advisor should be approached if an examiner/assessor is required stating the names of persons who wish to be assessed and category to be assessed. After ratification the information will be passed onto the FEDANSA National Executive.

THE ASSESSOR / EXAMINER.

- The Assessors / Examiners shall be appointed by the FEDANSA National Executive on an annual basis having received applications from registered members for such position.
- All accepted assessors / examiners shall attend a workshop especially designed for such purposes to ensure consistency in assessments.
- All assessors / examiners must be active in coaching, adjudicating and qualified for the specific branch that he/she will be assessing.
- The assessor / examiner will forward a signed report of the assessment to the National Technical Advisor within seven(7) days of the assessment.

THE NATIONAL TECHNICAL ADVISORY OFFICE.

- Shall forward the result of the assessment to the candidate within 14 days after the assessment.
- Shall forward the Coaches license to the candidate within 21 days after a successful assessment.
- Shall keep such records as due dates of re-assessments and / or due dates of assessments for next category.
- Shall ensure that all registered coaches will be posted on the FEDANSA website.

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
